One of the greatest authorities in the intersectionality between stress and addiction, Dr. Koob's illustrious career has focused on elucidating the neurobiological bases for the altered motivational states that are associated with the etiology of drug addiction using neurocircuitry, cellular, molecular, and behavioral approaches. Dr. Koob's work has significantly contributed to our current understanding of the neuroadaptations that take place in reward systems, as well as the recruitment of brain stress systems during the transition from casual use to dependence, with a particular emphasis on the negative emotional states that exacerbate the motivation to seek drugs.
